

Denture appointment flow

Consult appointment - Initial Consultation and diagnostics which include CBCT, Trios scan or alginate/ putty impressions, Studio and given consent forms

Surgery appointment - To remove the teeth and either insert an immediate denture or take further denture impressions

Try in appointment - To ensure that the denture fits and sits well and that the patient is happy with everything

Final insert appointment - Denture is inserted and bite is checked aswell to check if there is any sore spots that are needing to be polished

Soft reline appointment (full denture) - 4-6 weeks post surgery the patient will come back in for a review and to see if the denture is still sitting well post healing. If it is fitting poor they will do a temporary soft reline with a soft reline material that is done in the chair. This is a temporary material as the gums will still heal for the following 2-3 months.

Overdenture conversion - 3 months post implant surgery the patient will come in first appointment of the day and have the implants exposed and novaloc abutments will be placed. There will be a soft tissue impression taken with the denture and sent back to the lab for a hard reline, Patient will come back in the afternoon and have the denture fitted and make sure that it clicks on to the healing abutments well.

4 week review - A final check of the denture to make sure it is fitting well and that everything is fine. After this is done the patient will go back to there 6 monthly checkup and clean appointments.

Denture aftercare - To take good care of the dentures you should always remove them before going to sleep this will help your gums and the hygiene, Soak them in water over night once a month they should be soaked in denture cleaning tablets to help remove and debris. To clean them daily you will just need a soft bristle tooth brush and a small drop of gel tooth paste to brush them.
